

**MINUTES  
REGULAR CALLED CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
FEBRUARY 9, 2026**

The City Council of the City of Jasper, Texas, met on February 9, 2026, with the following members present to wit:

Mayor Clark McLane called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m., and Council Member Bob Mayhar opened it with prayer. All the members were present. Pastor Ray Charles Lewis/Nehemiah Family Life Center was presented a Certificate of Recognition for providing shelter during Winter Storm Fern. Linebarger Attorney Kevin Dutton presented the delinquent tax collection report. Municipal Court Clerk Jessica Ogg, Public Works Director Bob Gary, Light and Power Superintendent Lee Wellman, Solid Waste Foreman Wilmer Adams, Inspector Jeremy Chesnutt, Library Director Lindsey Cox, Captain Terry Patrick, Fire Marshall Brandon Duckworth, and Mr. Tom McClurg from JEDCO gave departmental reports.
