
The Council Committee Workshop was called to order by Mayor Randy Sayers at 11:00 a.m., and Mr. Steve Garcia gave the opening prayer. Council Member Michael Daniel was absent for the workshop. All other Council Members were present to wit.

Public Comments: (1) One was made by Mr. Steve Garcia who spoke regarding the Public Relations Officer position and made suggestions regarding the Request for Qualifications.


Mayor Sayers opened the Workshop with interviews and questions for the position of Public Relations Officer. The following were interviewed:

- # 1 Mr. Nicholas Gamache with Wifi Guy, LLC. A one-person crew who is willing to locate to Jasper with a yearly fee of \$100,000.00- and 24-hour support. His interview was from 11:00 a.m. to 11:36 a.m. with a 5-minute break for the council.
- # 2 Mr. Adam Arriaga with Texas Strategies out of Jasper Texas. This company has a team of employees with Tier pricing and suggested the Tier with the annual fee starting at \$292,100.00- and 24 hour support. His interview was from 11:41 a.m. to 12:57 p.m. with a 5-minute break for council.
- # 3 Mr. Josh Hadnot out of Jasper Texas. This company is a one-man team with an annual fee of \$126,000.00- and 24-hour support. His interview was from 1:10 p.m. to 2:00 p.m.

All three companies offering to develop, implement, and manage public relations and media as well as improving public relations, and establishing a brand that will help attract new residents to Jasper and the surrounding lakes area. There being no further questions from Council, Mayor Sayers adjourned the workshop at 2:05 p.m.

The Council Committee Workshop was called to order by Mayor Randy Sayers at 11:00 a.m., and he gave the opening prayer. All Council Members were present to wit.


There were no Public Comments, so Mayor Sayers opened the floor to Police Captain Mike Poindexter and Lieutenant Joshua Hadnot. Mr. Hadnot gave a power point presentation regarding in-car video systems, body cameras, tasers, and supporting hardware. After an in-depth review and questions from Council, Mr. Hadnot gave his recommendation to help modernize Jasper Police Department through the use of technology and requested a future approval regarding the Police Departments purchases with earmarked SRMPA funds of \$310,800.00 for police in- car video systems, tasers, and body cameras.

Dell Technologies laptops 5430 and Havis equipment for \$38,060.70 with added installation onsite (once quoted) with AT&T (FirstNet) SIM cards to provide cellular service to the laptops for 9 lines at \$30.00 per line totaling \$270.00 per month with (priority & preemption) over a two year (24 months) \$6,480.00 on the City account (\$3,240.00 a year). With the addition of Tyler Technologies for mobile CAD/RMS of \$5,412.00. Any equipment can be altered, which changes the price points as presented.


Any purchase made would not be completed and scheduled for installation until the 2023/2024 budget year due to production and quality of products being essential. After speaking with DELL representatives, the installation regarding outsourcing of onsite installation, it is safe to add an additional \$25,000 just to cover any projected installation pricing received along with increases as mentioned by Tyler Technologies for 5 years totaling a difference \$5,627.21.

Along with any additional changes in pricing or products prior to the 2023/2024 budget year. In total I would ask you to earmark approximately \$400,000 to adequately complete this project for a 5 year period that covers the mentioned information in this package. If funds are not spent, it is recommended they be put back into the SRMPA account for other use. Mayor and Council thanked Captain Poindexter and Lieutenant Hadnot for the presentation and supporting information.

There being no further questions or comments, Mayor Sayers adjourned the Workshop at 11:30 a.m.
