

MINUTES
REGULAR CALLED CITY COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 8, 2026

The City Council of the City of Jasper, Texas, met on June 8, 2026, with the following members present to wit:

Mayor Clark McLane called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m., and Judge Robert Jackson opened it with prayer. All council members were present. There were no public comments.

Council Member Bob Mayhar made a motion to approve the minutes from the Regular Called City Council Meeting on May 5, 2026. Council Member Lequin Hilderbrand seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Bob Mayhar made a motion to appoint Council Member Lequin Hilderbrand to the Sam Rayburn Municipal Power Agency (SRMPA). Council Member Katelyn Hanson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Daer Kyles made a motion to appoint Council Member Bob Mayhar to the South East Texas Regional Planning Commission (SETRPC). Council Member Lequin Hilderbrand seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Lequin Hilderbrand made a motion to approve the recommended bid from Goodwin Lasiter Strong (GLS) to award Capital Underground Utilities the bid for \$2,012,470.00 for Grant 24-065-082-E758. Council Member Mamie Horn seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Lequin Hilderbrand made a motion to approve the recommended bid from GLS to award Lilley Industrial Construction, Inc. the bid for \$1,084,272.50 for Grant 25-143-011-F347. Council Member Bob Mayhar seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Bob Mayhar made a motion to approve re-appointing Council Member Lequin Hilderbrand to a two-year term on the Jasper Economic Development Corporation (JEDCO), and appointing Bob Milner, Ross Horn, Dr. Larry Brown, Brenda Schofield, and Roger Westbrook to the JEDCO board. Council Member Daer Kyles seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Katelyn Hanson made a motion to approve changing the larger Sandy Creek Pavilion designation to a general-purpose pavilion to expand usage to a wider population. Council

Member Mamie Horn seconded the motion. Much discussion was held regarding a fee or deposit to use the pavilion and the rules for its use to be on the agenda for the next meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Lequin Hilderbrand made a motion to approve the resolution requesting the return of funds by the Jasper County Appraisal District, pursuant to Texas Tax Code Section 6.06(j). Council Member Katelyn Hanson seconded the motion. Discussion was made. The motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Bob Mayhar made a motion to approve allowing City Manager Greg Kelley to move forward with finalizing the zoning ordinance with Kendig Keast. Council Member Daer Kyles seconded the motion. Discussion was made. The motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Bob Mayhar made a motion to approve contracting with the Chamber of Commerce for marketing. The motion died due to lack of a second. Much discussion was made.

Council then went into executive session pursuant to Government Code 551, Section 551.074 personnel matters, section 551.074 personnel matters, and section 551.071 consultation with attorney at 6:28 pm. Council reconvened from executive session at 7:07 pm. No action was taken from executive session.

During the Council Time Discussion, Council Member Mamie Horn thanked everyone in Jasper for Corporal Stewart's bringing home. Council Member Lequin Hilderbrand mentioned that it was the most impactful moment of his life. Council Member Bob thanked everyone for being at the meeting and welcomed others to come to Jasper.

Council Member Lequin Hilderbrand made a motion to adjourn. Seconded by Council Member Mamie Horn. The motion passed unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 7:10 pm.
